Deadline for Application: June 30, of each year. Eligibility to Selection:

- 1. Daughter/Son, Grandchild, or Great-Grandchild of member in good standing of Nordahl Grieg Lodge #52, Sons of Norway, San Jose, California
- 2. Short-term/immediate education goal
- 3. At least one completed year of college or university, full time student
- 4. Successful academic performance by maintaining a cumulative minimum 2.75 GPA
- 5. Community involvement: clubs and/or organizations
- 6. Part-time employment and/or volunteer work
- 7. Write a brief personal history (400 words max.)
- 8. One (1) letter of recommendation from any of the following: Teacher, Employer, Counselor, Personal recommendation (Non-family member)
- 9. Most recent College transcript (unofficial or official)
- 10. Submission of completed scholarship application signed by applicant
- 11. Applicant must be no older than thirty (30) years of age. Applicant can have a Bachelor's or advanced degree and may be enrolled in a Master's degree or PhD program

Basis of Selection: All applicants must be submitted to the Screening Committee that is made up of three (3) members of the Nordahl Grieg Lodge. Members of the Screening Committee will be appointed by the President of Lodge. Members of Screening Committee are to be appointed in February of each year. The Screening Committee will review all applications, arrive at a consensus, and submit their recommendations to Nordahl Grieg Lodge for a final vote of approval.

Awards: The award will be made on a competitive basis, after review by the Screening Committee. All applicants will be notified in writing whether they receive or do not receive a scholarship.
