

**Nordahl Grieg Lodge 06-52**  
**Sons of Norway**  
**Policy Book**

1. The Annual Lutefisk Dinner shall be held over the weekend of the first Saturday of December. In the past the Lodge Vice President served as Chairperson. However, the Chair may be appointed or a volunteer.
2. The Counselor shall be in charge of the following year's Installation.
3. All social events are under the direction of the Social Director.
  - A. Lodge members actively serving, as officers will be admitted free to all Lodge functions and be exempt from solicitation in their capacities as officers of other contributions of their time and treasure.
  - B. Any member in good standing who sufficiently contributes to any social event be admitted free of charge to that event. The Chairperson of the event in question is given the authority and responsibility of naming those qualified for free entry.
4. Funding for delegates to District Conventions shall be determined before the election of delegates.
5. Delegates and alternates to a District Convention shall be elected at the same time. The number of votes by secret ballot received by each candidate shall determine the placement.
6. Annual donations to the Sons of Norway Recreation Center and the District Scholarship Fund shall be paid from the General Fund.
7. Members of the Lodge providing services for programs sponsored by the Lodge at Nordahl Hall may accept remuneration for services with prior permission of the Lodge or the Executive Board of the Lodge. If in the future any member feels this amended policy is being abused, they may move for an additional amendment.
  - A. Lodge members are encouraged to donate their time and talents toward the benefit of the Lodge and its members without financial compensation.
8. The third year Trustee (newly elected) will serve as the Foundation Director and receives and disseminates information from Sons of Norway home office regarding scholarships and grants and other Foundation activities.
9. The third year Trustee may hold a fund raiser for Sons of Norway Foundation. However, Nordahl Grieg Lodge has designated the Coin March monies collected at each Lodge meeting be held for the Sons of Norway Foundation. At the end of the year, the third year Trustee should request the Treasurer send those funds to the Foundation.

10. The second year Trustee serves as the Scholarship Chair for all Lodge scholarships, either to Language Heritage Camp at Camp Norge or to graduating high school seniors from the Gunderson-Delphy Scholarship Fund.
11. Up to four (4) scholarships may be awarded to the Language Heritage Camp for the children and grandchildren of Nordahl Grieg Lodge Members. These scholarships shall be one-half the camp fee.
12. A scholarship shall be given each year to a graduating high school senior. The amount to be determined by the available interest earned on Gunderson-Delphy Fund held at the Sons of Norway home office.
13. At the Anniversary Dinner all anniversaries for the entire year shall be honored. (5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35 and 50 year, plus Golden Membership, etc.) and will be awarded appropriately.
14. The first person named for a committee shall be the chairperson unless it is necessary to have a vote. In that case, the person receiving the most votes shall be the chairperson.
15. No alcoholic beverages shall be brought into the Lodge Hall during meetings. The President shall inform the bartender ten minutes before the meeting is to start.
16. Each Committee (Scholarship, Lutefisk, Library or Hall Improvement) shall have established procedures and written guidelines.
17. These policies may be changed or amended provided that any such change has been presented in writing and read at a prior business meeting of the Lodge. A two-thirds majority vote of the members present is needed for passage.
