2013 Annual Report to the Membership by the Board of Directors March 14, 2014

Nordahl Hall, Inc. was incorporated as a California Non-profit Corporation on August 17, 1967.

Article II, Section A of the By-laws states that "the Board of Directors shall supervise the affairs of the corporation and shall have full power to do any and all things necessary and proper for the welfare of the corporation pursuant to law, the Articles of Incorporation, and these By-laws."

The following individuals served on the Board of Directors during 2013:

- 2011 – 2013 Term: **Larry Hulberg, Mark Hunsbedt, Earl Rosebraugh**
- 2012 – 2014 Term: **Ginny Hansen, Don Schallock, Paul Nore**
- 2013 – 2015 Term: **Fred Hymans, Vicki Everly, Dave Melius**
- Lodge President: **Shirley Shoup**
- Lodge Vice-President: **Vidar Dallokken**

Officers: President, **Larry Hulberg**, and Treasurer, **Fred Hymans**. Secretary (vacant) but covered by **Vicki Everly** and **Shirley Shoup**. Terms expiring this year include **Larry Hulberg, Mark Hunsbedt** and **Earl Rosebraugh**, all have agreed to serve another term (subject to election by Lodge members).

Janie Kelly, operating through her business Viking Property Management, has been our Rental Manager since March 2011. Under her stewardship, the appearance and cleanliness of the Hall have improved, needed maintenance has been performed, and rental activity has increased significantly, with income down only slightly from the prior year despite several cancellations.

The "Love Your Lodge" campaign has raised significant donations, allowing us to accomplish several projects this past year and start planning for others. Our sincere thanks to all those who have contributed. We also received a \$1,000 donation from the **Village School** as a "thank you" for continued use of our parking lot.

We've come a long way, thanks to the donations of our members and hard work of many individuals, especially **Don Schallock, Dave Melius, Kato Andersen, John Stubblebine, Mark Hunsbedt** and **Bruce Fihe**. Major projects accomplished this year include:

- Demolishing the roof overhang
- Repairing stucco and installing flashing on the south and west sides of the building
- Replacing the kitchen door and rebuilding the frame around the hall entry doors
- Painting the exterior
- Installing a new 5-ton HVAC unit
- Establishing WiFi internet connection
- Upgrading the audio system
- Replacing drop ceiling light panels in the kitchen
- Refurbishing partitions in both restrooms
- Installing a picture railing in the Solveig Room
- Upgrading the Nordahl Hall website (www.nordahlhall.com)

February 2014 Business Meeting Highlights

(condensed from minutes approved in March 2014)

- President **Shirley Shoup** introduced **Marilyn Wall** who is a member and **Joanne Bjerkhoel's** sister. **Liv Braaten** introduced her grandsons **Andrew** (age 12) and **Jack** (age 9), and friend **Stan. Lian Dalløkken**, Vidar's wife, was also present.
- Minutes of the January 24, 2014 meeting were approved as submitted.
- Financial Secretary **Kari Warner** reported receiving dues from International.
- Treasurer **Mike Block** was absent but provided a brief financial report via President Shoup.
- Cultural Director **Elaine Edwards** announced that a survey has been created to find out members' interest in the cultural programs.
- Scholarship Chair **Elderid Everly** announced campership availability with a deadline date of May 1.
- **Ginny Hansen** provided a follow-up to last year's work as Scholarship Chair regarding establishing the Nordahl Grieg College Scholarship. Motion was passed to accept the application and criteria as submitted. Scholarship application deadline is June 30. A screening committee is to be appointed each February to review applications and submit recommendations to the lodge for final vote of approval.
- A motion was passed to provide a \$500 per delegate stipend for delegates attending the 6th District convention in Palm Springs. The following delegates were elected to represent Nordahl Grieg: **Shirley Shoup, Harry Bjerkhoel, Bruce Fihe, Karen Aaker, Ginny Hansen, Joanne Bjerkhoel, Elaine Edwards, and Judy Purrington.**
- A motion was passed to produce a half-page, black and white advertisement for the convention booklet.
- Members were encouraged to submit handcrafts to the convention's Folk Art Exhibition.
- February birthday greetings were extended to members in attendance. Anniversary greetings were extended to **Kari Warner** who came to this country 55 years ago, and to **Liv Braaten** who emigrated 50 years ago.
- President Shoup presented a "sweet" surprise for sweethearts in attendance. The couple that has been sweethearts the longest were **Marv and Lois Bertelson** who have been sweethearts for 63 years. Sweethearts for the shortest time... 4 years this summer for **Lian and Vidar Dalløkken.**
- **Lois Bertelson** announced that 14 pounds of stamps were recently delivered to the Seaman's Church in San Francisco. A total of 40 pounds and 4 boxes of a stamp collection were collected in the last year.
- It was announced that there will be no Norway Day this year due to financial and leadership challenges.
