Greetings Fellow Lodge Members:

This month, I want to follow up on last month's President's message about how important Nordahl Hall is to our Lodge membership. As I mentioned last month, our Hall is our anchor. We have the luxury of using it for many of our functions, events, and programs throughout the year.

Other Lodges in the Bay Area have lost or sold their buildings over the years due to various reasons. Those Lodges are struggling to gain new members, and their membership is dwindling.

It is really important that we not lose Nordahl Hall. Last month, I mentioned that the Nordahl Hall Board has embarked on a plan to improve the look of our interior space in order to help increase our rental income.

I am pleased to report that the women's and men's bathroom improvements were completed on schedule last month. Please see the photo of the new look! We thank the Solveig Club for their generous donation for the bathroom improvements. Additionally, the foyer interior doors and trim have been painted to lighten that area, and planning is underway to replace the foyer tile with a contemporary style and a lighter color this fall. Earlier this spring, the parking lot walls and rear storage containers were freshly painted. We also planted a new garden including paver stones, installed a new irrigation system, replaced bar baseboards, and installed a new bar plumbing system.

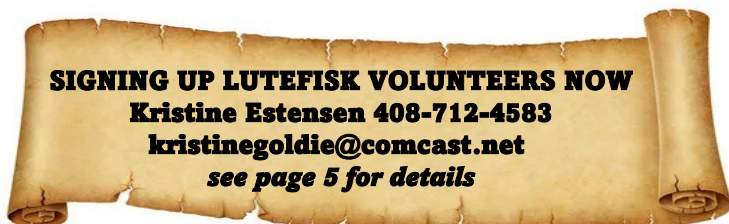

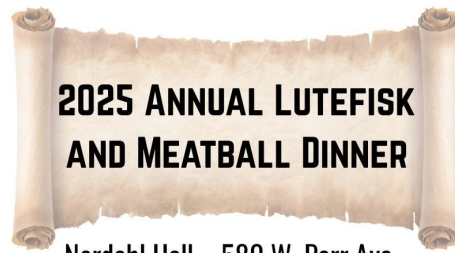

Thank you for your interest in our “Hall Floor Modernization Campaign.” We are asking for your help to make a special contribution to our Love Your Lodge fund specifically for replacing our 1980s hall and bar flooring.
