FREE Sons of Norway Heritage membership for young relatives aged 15 and under.

Heritage membership offers current Sons of Norway members an easy and free way to share their love of Norwegian traditions and culture with young family members. New Heritage members receive a Welcome Kit and Sons of Norway ID card, along with ideas for celebrating Nordic heritage.

Heritage members must be related to the sponsoring Sons of Norway member – most often a parent or grandparent – but they are not required to be part of the same household. At age 16, Heritage members have the option of joining Sons of Norway as an adult Individual member or as part of a Family membership, if one exists at their home address.

New Year's Speeches in Norway

King Haakon VII of Norway began the tradition of giving a New Year's Eve speech in 1940. It was the first new year after Norway was occupied by Germany during WWII, and the Royal Family was living abroad. These radio addresses were a way for the King to speak directly to the Norwegian people. Although few had radios at the time (because they had been confiscated by the Nazis), word of what the King said quickly spread throughout the nation.

During his exile in London, King Haakon VII made several radio broadcasts to the American people via the BBC, expressing gratitude for the United States' support and steadfast friendship. One such address was on New Year's Day in 1943 when King Haakon gave a speech to the American people thanking them for their support during the war. Fifty years after the war, a memorial was unveiled in Oslo to honor the American soldiers who died in Norway during WWII, a gesture from Norwegian veterans ensuring their sacrifice would not be forgotten.

COMPLETED HALL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS: The Nordahl Hall Board has worked hard to improve the look of our interior and exterior space in order to attract more renters to increase our income. Improvements made so far include:

- Replaced bar baseboards and installed a new bar plumbing system – April 2025
- Painted parking lot walls and rear storage containers – May 2025
- Planted new garden and installed paver stones and new irrigation timer system – May 2025
- Painted foyer interior doors and door trim white – August 2025
- Installed new vanities, sinks, and faucets in the women's and men's restrooms – September 2025
- Installed new contemporary floor tile in the entrance foyer and women's lounge as well as fresh paint in those areas – November 2025
