INTERESTED IN SERVING AS A DELEGATE AT DISTRICT 6 CONVENTION June 11-14, 2026?

- Nordahl Grieg Lodge is now accepting nominations to attend the Sons of Norway District 6 Convention, June 11-14, in Sacramento. You may self-nominate or nominate others that are interested in attending. Conventions occur every 2 years.
- Nordahl Grieg Lodge is allowed **6 elected delegates** who have voting authority on District 6 policy issues. Delegates must be a Sons of Norway, and Nordahl Grieg Lodge member.
- The Nominees will be voted on by the membership at the next Lodge Zoom meeting on March 23 at 7:00pm.
- Nordahl Grieg Lodge will provide each of the 6 elected delegates a maximum stipend of \$600 to use towards the registration fee, hotel, meals, and travel expenses.
- District 6 includes Sons of Norway lodges and members from 7 states: California, Utah, Nevada, Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico, and Hawaii.
- Delegates are required to be in attendance for the entire Saturday and Sunday District 6 Lodge Meeting sessions, and preferably for Friday Day at Camp Norge.
- Any lodge member may register as a guest.

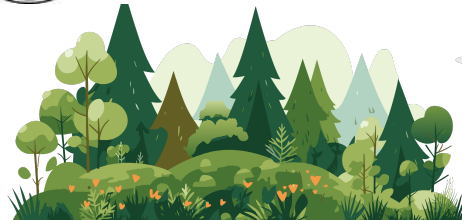

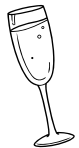

Norway Olympics Updates!

At the 2026 Winter Olympics in Milan and Cortina d'Ampezzo (Feb 6–22), Norway finished at the top of the final medal standings with the following official count:

Gold: 18

Silver: 12

Bronze: 11

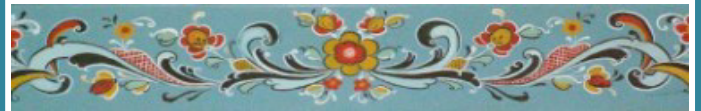
Total: 41 medals

This marked Norway's first-place finish in both total medals and gold medals, and those 18 golds set a new record for most gold medals by any country at a single Winter Olympics.

Norwegian athletes have dominated in skiing disciplines, especially cross-country skiing, biathlon, Nordic combined, and ski jumping.

Nordic powerhouse Johannes Høsflot Klæbo has been historic — he's extended the record for most Winter Olympic gold medals ever, winning his 11th Olympic gold medal at these Games.
