

## En hilsen fra Nordahl Grieg Presidenten

Greetings Nordahl Grieg Lodge members:

We had our Lodge's 80th anniversary celebration on March 7th. We enjoyed an excellent dinner and awards program. We honored 39 members with longevity service pins, and 22 members with Special Awards. There were 60 attendees, which was 18 more people than last year. I hope you found the food and company outstanding. Our caterer prepared the cod almondine, hearty beef stew, with tender spring asparagus to perfection.

In March, we accomplished two things to increase our outreach and advertising for Nordahl Grieg Lodge and Nordahl Hall, with the use of email distribution software, and social media:

- **New email distribution to Friends of Nordahl Grieg Lodge:**

The lodge voted to purchase software (\$300) so that we can regularly communicate by email, with friends of Nordahl Grieg Lodge. These are people who have attended past events and are acquainted with our Lodge, but are not members yet. This list will be used to advertise our main events, such as Syttende Mai Brunch and Lutefisk Dinner; expanding interest and participation with our Lodge, and hopefully increasing membership. Without this software, we would use the US Postal service to mail our advertisements. Thank you to **Bruce Fihe**, our Webmaster, for the idea and setting up this process!

- **Rent Nordahl Hall ad on Craig's List:**

We have a goal to take advantage of free, or low cost social media platforms to advertise that Nordahl Hall is available to rent. **Misa Hosohama**, of the **Haug** family, has created an ad for us on Craig's list, for \$5.00 per month. She is donating the first year's cost, and the Hall will continue after that. Thank you so much **Misa Hosohama!** Do we have other members who can help us create and maintain ads with Instagram, Tik-tok, and Facebook media? We could use your assistance.

## FREE Sons of Norway Heritage membership for young relatives aged 15 and under.

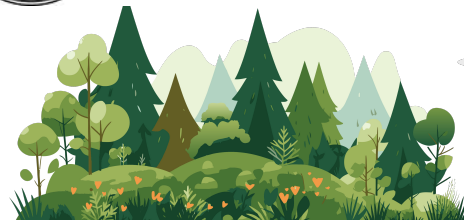

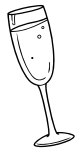

## Jannike Mikkelsen



Jannike Mikkelsen is Norway's first astronaut, flying on the privately funded Fram2 mission launched by SpaceX on March 31, 2025. The mission—led by entrepreneur Chun Wang—was the first human spaceflight to orbit over Earth's poles and conducted 22 experiments, including research on northern lights and the effects of space travel. After nearly four days, the crew safely splashed down off California.

Mikkelsen is also an accomplished filmmaker, technologist, and former athlete. She previously helped set a world record for circumnavigating the globe via both poles and has worked on innovative projects in virtual reality, filmmaking, and 3D technology, collaborating with figures like David Attenborough and contributing to major productions. Despite a childhood injury that temporarily left her paraplegic, she pursued interests in science, sports, and filmmaking from a young age. Today, she specializes in advanced filming technologies for extreme environments and continues to push boundaries in both space exploration and visual storytelling.
