There are so many volunteers to thank; we will include everyone in our next Tidende, but I especially want to mention our leadership team who created, planned, organized, adapted, and executed this event perfectly! **Jeannie Thomson**, who created the selection of buffet and appetizer items, led the prep of the appetizers and buffet food, gathered wonderful volunteers who created the impressive array of desserts, and organized the beautiful raffle items. Because of Jeannie's significant advance publicity efforts, we enjoyed having many Daughters of Norway members, and Oakland Lodge members in attendance. **Kristine Estensen**, who recruited an army of volunteers well ahead of time; volunteer teams included a Greeter team to welcome our guests, and a throng of hardworking family and friends to work in the kitchen. In addition, Kristine worked with **Jim Sturtevant** to create nearly 200 name badges. **Barbara Shoup**, who suggested the idea of a champagne brunch, found an egg recipe to serve 190 people, worked on 10 batches of waffles, helped set up the beautiful tables, selected all the items for the children's activity table, and was able to score our own excellent face painter, **Laura Hulberg!** **Meg Laycock**, who brought in our *Lur* (wooden horn), dancers, and musicians; created a wonderful program of traditional dances; and engaged the audience in a children's dance and participation dance. Meg also sang the Norwegian National Anthem, worked in the Solveig Club Bazaar, and helped with setup and food prep.

Dugnad, pronounced doog' – nahd (with a very soft "d" at the end) means volunteer help or support in Norwegian, and is a custom of shared work that dates back centuries. It's meant to be social and fun, and is seen as strengthening the community. Dugnad has become so entrenched in Norway that in 2004 dugnad was voted Norway's word of the year.

The list of tasks for our Hall dugnad on June 7 includes, but is not limited to:

- Wash windows
- Repair kitchen door frame and replace doorknob and lock
- Fix stage/sound closet doorknob
- Touch up paint on the scuffed door trims and baseboards in main hall
- Sand and paint rusted sections of the toilet stalls in both bathrooms
- Sand and paint the donated bench in the ladies' lounge
- Sanitize dishwasher, polish stainless steel appliances, clean kitchen surfaces

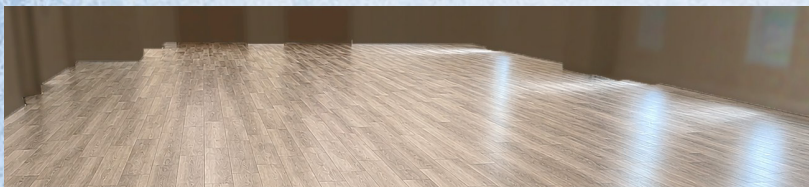

Let's not forget our youth. Young people up to age 18 are invited to display their work as well.
