Greetings Nordahl Grieg Lodge members, and friends of Nordahl Grieg Lodge: July is when the summer really starts for me; I love the warm days and beautiful cool evenings in the Bay Area. It's also Norway's peak summer month marked by the Midnight Sun in the north and warm, lush weather across the fjords and cities. Norwegians celebrate summer by heading to mountain cabins, boating, attending outdoor festivals, hiking, fjord cruising, and city exploring. It's also the perfect time to take advantage of Norway's Arctic regions by visiting the Lofoten Islands or Svalbard to experience perpetual daylight.



Norwegians love festivals! There is St. Olav Festival in Trondheim around July 29th, to celebrate the patron saint of the country, honored for unifying the nation and establishing Christianity; the Gladmat Festival, held in Stavanger, known as Scandinavia's largest food festival; and Riddu Riddu, an internationally recognized indigenous festival held in Katjord, two hours outside of Tromsø, celebrating Sami and other global indigenous cultures.

In the USA, we have our own very special July 4th to celebrate 250 years since the adoption of the Declaration of Independence by the Second Continental Congress in 1776. I hope you take advantage of this holiday, by enjoying spectacular fireworks shot directly over the Golden Gate bridge, going to a festival or barbeque, or enjoying the festivities planned in Washington D.C. at the National Mall, celebrating with military band performances, exciting flyovers, and fireworks.

Their viral Viking-themed team photo has only added to the buzz around the squad, capturing the spirit and swagger of a team eager to make history. Combining clinical finishing, disciplined defending, and growing confidence, Norway has quickly become one of the tournament's standout stories as they chase their deepest World Cup run since 1998.

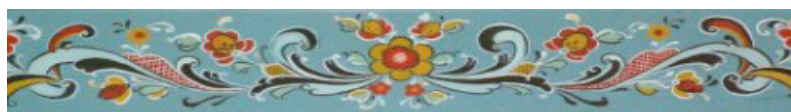
