Greetings Nordahl Grieg Lodge members, and friends of Nordahl Grieg Lodge:

This month I would like to talk about our wonderful asset, owned by Nordahl Grieg Lodge —NORDAHL HALL. The textbook definition of an asset is: “any item, resource, or quality that has economic or practical value and is owned or controlled by a person, group or business. It can bring financial gain or provide useful advantage.”

The textbook definition falls SHORT of what NORDAHL HALL means to Nordahl Grieg Lodge. For our Lodge, our Hall provides:

1. A place where there is a sense of community through our common bond with Norwegian and Scandinavian heritage, culture, and food,
2. A welcoming space to meet people with shared interests to connect through social events, and to have fun,
3. A place for Nordahl Grieg Lodge members and friends to gather to maintain continuity of activities since this Lodge was chartered in 1947,
4. A venue for our Lodge to continue holding our “signature” event and major fundraiser for 77 years: The Lutefisk and Meatball Dinner.

Quite literally, our Hall is our “anchor” and provides us a huge advantage to keep Nordahl Grieg Lodge viable. Without our Hall, we could not hold our annual Lutefisk and Meatball dinner, we could not plan any significant Syttende Mai events or Ice Cream Socials, the Solveig Club would not have a place to hold their popular holiday bazaar with their unique Nordic gifts, we could not support our community events such as blood drives, Boy Scout activities, donation drives for food and clothing, or support the parents and kids at the Village School.



In early August, our longtime member and Past President, **Laura Porter**, was married to Michael Roman at Nordahl Hall. Here is what she said after the happy event:

“Everyone loved the hall and thought it was a wonderful space to have events. I truly hope that more lodge members utilize the hall for their events in the future. It is such a wonderful space and as lodge members we really need to understand how special it is for us to have a location like this. So many lodges across the country are having to sell their physical locations and we really need to understand how special it is that we are able to keep our location.”

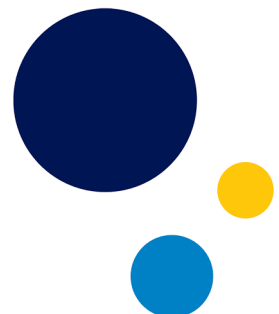

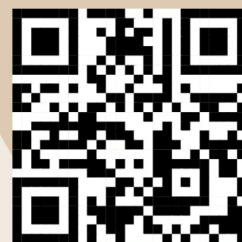
